16h00: Drive towards Hella for our first overnight's stay at hotel Ranga (145 km / 2h)



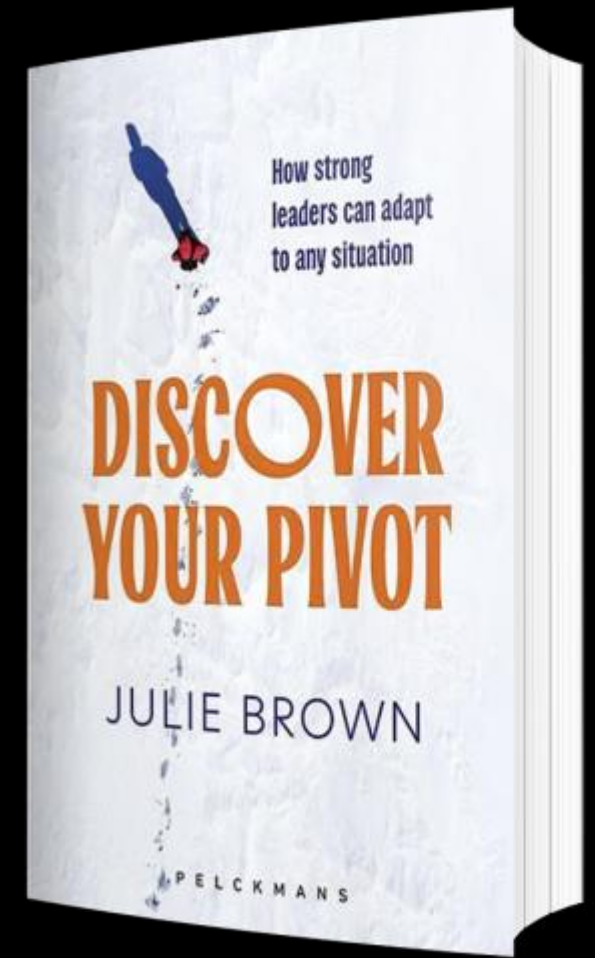
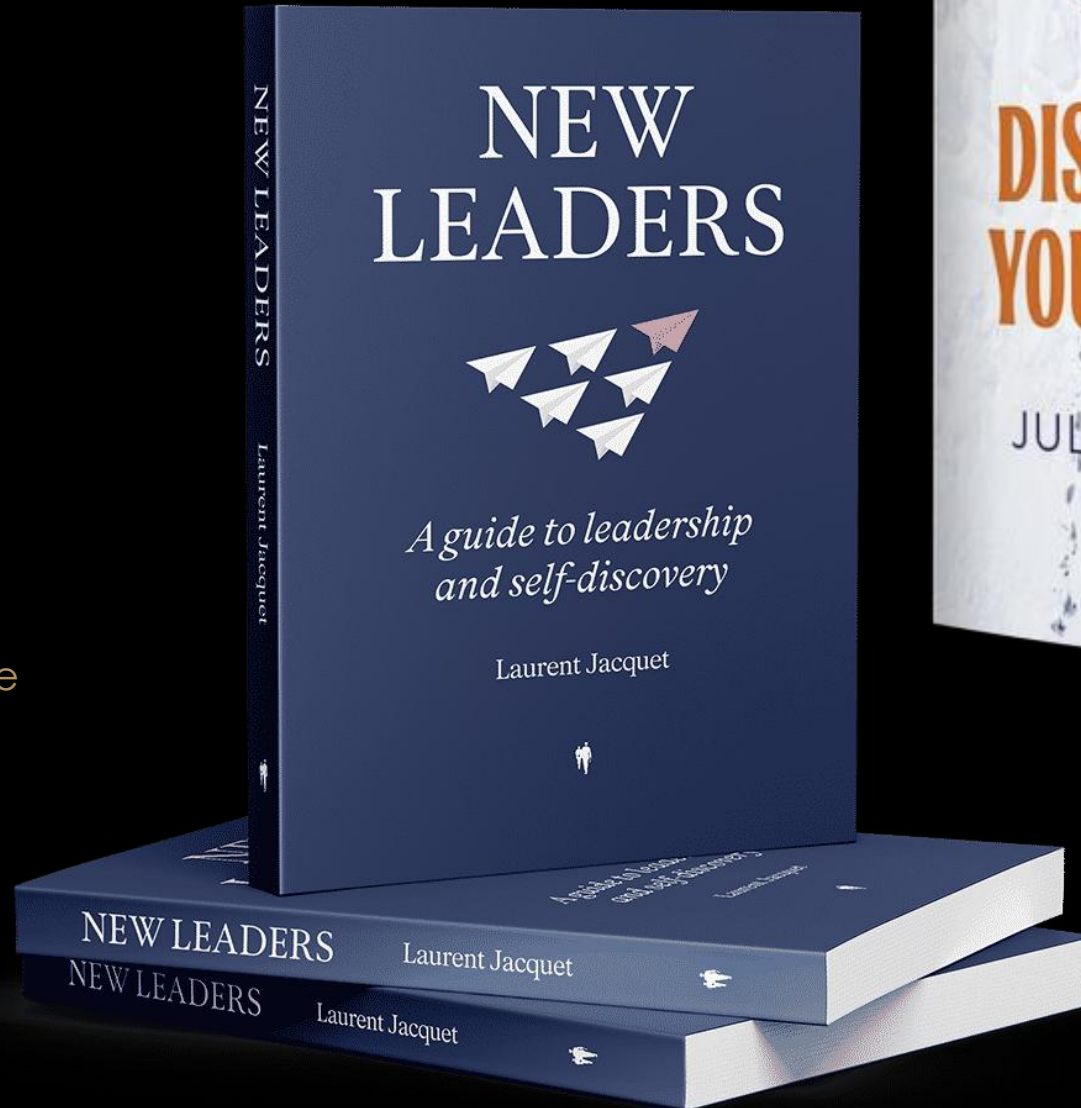
First round table dinner at Hótel Rangá

Staying at: Hótel Rangá

A luxury countryside hotel in Southern Iceland. It offers all the facilities and services of a modern resort. Located between the towns of Hella and Hvolsvöllur, it lies just off the main road right in middle of South Iceland's panoramic scenery.

The resort is built in log-cabin style and has through the years acquired an excellent reputation for its gourmet food, accommodation and service. It is the first Icelandic hotel to become a member of the prestigious international hotel chain Great Hotels of the World.

Hótel Rangá is a favorite hotel amongst Icelanders both in winter and summer and is really well located for adventure tours and various attractions, including Eyjafjallajökull, the Golden Circle and the Glacier Lagoon (Jökulsárlón).



5.Oct – Þórsmörk Glacier Valley & the Southshore

Self-drive Land Rover Super Defender

Now it's time to test your driving skills!

The Land Rover Super Defender is built especially for Icelandic conditions. With 38" tires, the Land Rover Super Defender is an unstoppable 4x4 machine that can traverse any kind of terrain. The large tires, onboard air compressor, auxiliary headlamps, along with the snorkel and the inbuilt VHF radio, allow this vehicle to be driven in otherwise impassable conditions.

By deflating the tires, the Land Rover Super Defender has more grip and flotation, which enables this vehicle to be driven on top of deep snow. The modification to big tires adds stability, as the width of the vehicle increases more than the height from the road, thus making the center of gravity proportionately lower than that of the original vehicle.



Pórsmörk Glacier Valley

After having explored Sólheimajökull you will drive towards the majestic Pórsmörk Glacier Valley.

Shaped by glaciers, this extraordinary valley is at the beginning of Iceland's interior, surrounded by 3 glaciers; Tindfjallajökull, Eyjafjallajökull & Mýrdalsjökull.

Driving into the glacier valley you will visit the beautiful waterfalls Seljalandsfoss and Gljúfrabúi.

Seljalandsfoss is a striking waterfall which you can walk behind and enjoy from a different angle.

Gljúfrabúi waterfall, which is 40 m tall, is very interesting and unique as it is partially masked by its own canyon.

You will end your day by enjoying a delicious BBQ dinner in this beautiful landscape before going on a nice hike with your guide or going on a thrilling ATV Tour driving out of Pórsmörk.

When in Thorsmork, a delicious BBQ dinner will be awaiting you.

After dinner, go and chase the Northern Lights with Hinrik, photographer and Iceland guide...

The Básar hut, tucked in between the mountains in Þórsmörk valley, where you will be sleeping this evening, is the ideal location with no light pollution, to spot the Northern Lights.

The hut has running water and showers.



6.Oct - Landmannalaugar

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Landmannalaugar

Now it's time for another highland adventure...

First we head out of Þórsmörk and soon our next adventure begins. We pass by the mountain Einhyrningur or "Unique horn" before we arrive at the spectacular canyon Markafjótsgljúfur and head towards the mountain Einhyrningur.

Continuation towards the beautiful Landmannalaugar. It is located at the edge of Laugahraun lava field which was formed in an eruption around the year 1477. It is known for its natural geothermal hot springs and surrounding multicolored landscape.

Upon arrival you can enjoy a hike or a nice bath in the natural pool before having a delicious dinner at your hut.



Staying at Landmannalaugar Hut

Your hut is located about 600 metres above sea level at the edge of the lava field Laugahraun on a few hot springs, which create excellent bathing conditions in a natural brook.

The dwelling hut is two storeys high and offers sleeping bag accommodations for you and your fellow entrepreneurs.

The ground floor comprises a spacey entry, a large sleeping hall, a kitchen and a storage room.

Upstairs are three large sleeping rooms and one small. The house is heated the whole year round and gas is used for cooking. All necessary appliances are in the kitchen.

Outside is a large house with WC and showers.



7.Oct – Landmannalaugar, Hekla & Þhingvellir

From Landmannalaugar to Þingvellir Area

Today you will be exploring the interior of Iceland even further with your jeeps.

Get ready for a breathtaking drive traversing the diverse landscapes of Iceland, from the vibrant rhyolite mountains of Landmannalaugar to the historic rift valley of Þingvellir.

Pass by the Hekla volcano, one of Iceland's most active volcanoes. Explore the vast Þjórsárdalur Valley, home to ancient Viking ruins and stunning waterfalls.



Exclusive farewell dinner at Adventure Hotel

Imagine an unforgettable evening, where culinary artistry meets breathtaking sceneries.

Immerse yourself in Iceland's raw beauty, on the edge of Þingvellir National Park, in a landscape of lichen and long-dormant lava fields.

ION Adventure Hotel, built largely from reclaimed and renewable materials, heated geothermically, has the otherworldly landscapes angle covered.

The price for this five days adventure costs 6.900 euros per person. This price is determined on the basis of 16 registrations. If this number is not reached, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the trip or recalculate the cost per person.
